NOTICE OF TELEPHONIC PUBLIC HEARING AND MEETING HELD DURING PUBLIC HEALTH

Notice is hereby given that the Boards of Supervisors (“Boards”) of the Brooks of Bonita Springs and Brooks of Bonita Springs II Community Development Districts (“Districts”) will hold a Joint Telephonic Public Meeting of the Boards on April 22, 2020 at 1:00 p.m., at **1-888-354-0094, CONFERENCE ID: 8593810**, pursuant to Executive Orders 20-52 and 20-69 issued by Governor DeSantis on March 9, 2020, and March 20, 2020, respectively, and pursuant to Section 120.54(5)(b)2., Florida Statutes. At such time the Boards are so authorized and may consider a joint proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021, consider resolutions related to the Districts upcoming general elections, adopt an internal controls policy and address any other business that may properly come before the Boards, which are necessary for the proper operation of Districts.

The meeting is open to the public and will be conducted in accordance with the provisions of Florida law for community development districts. The meeting may be continued to a date, time, and place to be specified on the record at such meeting. There may be occasions when Board Supervisors or District Staff may participate by speaker telephone.
